PORT WASHINGTON, WI – MAY 25, 2011 ... Franklin Energy Services LLC, a leading national energy efficiency services company based in Port Washington, WI, received two awards for the recent development of their headquarters, which incorporates multiple energy efficient technologies. The Milwaukee Business Journal bestowed the Best New Development or Renovated Office Award, and Illuminating Engineering Society of North America (IES) recognized the firm with a Section Award for Energy and Environmental Design.

This office's complex Heating, Ventilating and Air Conditioning (HVAC) system, 100% digitally addressable lighting control system and state-of-the-art water saving fixtures have qualified Franklin Energy's Headquarter for numerous energy efficiency awards for office design, and catalyzed an effort to seek LEED Certification. Together these systems target the reduction of the suite's lighting power by 27%, building water usage by 40% and HVAC savings of 38%. This will yield an estimated 38% overall reduction in building energy cost, which should save roughly \$11,000 in utility costs annually.

A Business Journal panel of judges evaluated entries based on merits, financial success and positive impact on the community. The IES Illumination Awards recognize professionalism, ingenuity and originality in lighting design.

Franklin Energy employs about 50 corporate staff at its headquarters and an additional 240 employees within 19 other offices in nine states. It has been named a Best Places to Work and Future 50 Company in southeastern Wisconsin.

Franklin Energy contracts with utilities, municipalities, and states to provide on their behalf energy efficiency programs to end use customers including Commercial, Industrial and Residential customers.
